CAADP FRAMEWORK

- ❑ Agriculture-led growth to reach MDG1
- ❑ Target Goal of 6% Sector growth rate
- ❑ Increased public investment (10% budget share)
- ❑ Policy efficiency, peer review, accountability
- ❑ Exploitation of regional complementarities

CAADP Principles –Country Level

1. Build on ongoing efforts at national level - avoid parallel planning/duplication
2. Aligning national efforts with the CAADP Targets
 - GROWTH (6%)
 - BUDGETARY (10%)
 - FOOD AND NUTRITION SECURITY (MDG1)
3. Add Value to national efforts

Stock taking

- Past performance & long term prospects of poverty reduction and food security efforts

Policy and strategy alignment

- EDPRS and PSTA to align to CAADP agenda

Value addition to national efforts

- Identification of poverty reducing sources of growth
- Projections of long term investment needs
- Concept design for knowledge systems and review mechanisms

Objectives of the roundtable

Ensure that the country is on track to achieve CAADP Growth and Budgetary objectives

- Identify possible gaps in terms of sector policy, budgetary and investment measures
- Provide an opportunity to share lessons and experience with other member states

Objectives of the Compact

To guide the implementation of national strategies in the long term:

1. Clarification of commitments in terms of sector policies, public expenditures, and development assistance
2. Establishment of partnerships and alliance for successful implementation of EDPRS/PSTA
3. Creation of a mechanism for peer review and dialogue to track implementation and progress in meeting the commitments
