Underlying Factors/assumptions

- **Need Comprehensive menu of Actions beyond Early Actions > Good Strategic planning**

Additional Areas:

1.1 **SUSTAINABLE LAND MANAGEMENT**

- 1) Access to Short-term targeted fertilizer subsidy (Soil fertility improvement).
- 2) Land Use Mgt./Administration:
 - (a) Biological Resources Mgt.
 - (b) Agro-forestry/Conservation
Agriculture for increasing productivity
- 3) Formation of Working Group on SLM, climate and livelihoods > AUC/NEPAD/COMESA to initiate (links to ICRAF/WWF)

INVESTMENT AREAS Con'td

- 4) TerrAfrica - Strengthen adaptation and coordination on the CAADP-TerrAfrica framework at both regional and country level**
- 5) Biological Resources property rights and Indigenous Knowledge patenting eg. plant products of medicinal value.**

1.2 SUSTAINABLE WATER RESOURCES MANAGEMENT

- 1) Monitoring > Water use versus water table recession.**
- 2) Irrigation development – consider other utilization e.g. Aquaculture and livestock watering/rangeland dev.**
- 3) Drainage/industrial waste water re-use for Irrigation.**
- 4) Trans-boundary shared water resources Management.**

- 5) Conflict Management & Policy frameworks for Internationally shared water resources (Resource abundance ?).**
- 6) On-farm water management for users at field level- capacity building.**
- 7) Early flood Warning Systems to be developed.**
- 8) TerrAfrica approach > Watershed Mgt, Env.Mgt, Flood control/Drainage.**
- 9) Natural Resources and water management to include other river basins apart from the**
