3. Making Markets Work for the Poor: Enhancing Food Security and Productivity Growth in Eastern and Southern Africa (MMWP) funded World Bank/DFID (\$3.8 million)
4. Improved Regional Trade in Food Staples (RTFS), \$5 million, start up funding World Bank
5. Cassava Transformation in Southern Africa (CATISA), total \$2 million, startup funding SIDA
6. Home-Grown School Feeding (HGSF), funded WFP and DFID (\$25 million)
7. **Banana Processing and Fortification Initiative**
8. **Orange Fleshed Sweet Potato Initiative**
